## Guardian Web Application V3.61.0

### New Features

- Bulk Approve Changes
  - Removed 50,000 record limit for bulk approvals in Change Report tab.
- Bulk Unignore Changes
  - Added “Unignore Changes” option in Approve Changes drop-down.
  - Allows restoring multiple ignored items in one action.

### Other Enhancements

- Freshservice Integration Improvements
  - Added new configuration fields:
    - Change Start Indicator
    - Change End Indicator

- Complete Status
  - Close Status
- Filter by Change Indicator
  - Indicators in Change Report tab are now clickable for filtering.
  - Multiple indicators can be combined for refined views.
- Case-Insensitive Sorting
  - Lists and menus now sort alphabetically regardless of case.
- Change Report PDF Cover
  - Exported PDF cover page now displays applied filters.
- Cancel Date Range Changes
  - Ability to cancel date range selection without applying changes.
- Faster Change Approval
  - Improved performance for approving large volumes of changes.

## **Fixed Issues**

- GWB-6378 – Search filter now works across all levels of change record names.
- GWB-5244 – Dynamic node groups now correctly handle IP range arrays.
- GWB-6386 – Backslashes in variables for file scan options now properly escaped.
- GWB-6382 – Warning icon for Connection Manager Groups now displays correctly.
- GWB-6347 – Description field for approval reason is no longer mandatory.
- GWB-6384 – Expand/collapse logic fixed for multiple changes.
